Take leadership to the next level. Run for Lieutenant Governor.

Are you ready to advance your Key Club leadership? Consider running for a position on the Georgia District Key Club Board of Trustees as a lieutenant governor.

Lieutenant governors (LTGs) have the responsibility of representing the Georgia District's 15 divisions — by sharing information with local club leaders and faculty advisors; holding division-wide events and service projects; and assisting clubs with their unique needs.

LTGs play a vital role in moving our organization forward. Along the way, they create lasting impacts and relationships with their clubs.

How to run for Lieutenant Governor

Lieutenant Governors will be elected during divisional caucuses at the 2018 District Convention. LTGs are elected by delegates from their division **only** (e.g., LTG elections are not district-wide elections).

Candidates **must attend** district convention to run for election. Each **club** may nominate no more than **one** candidate for LTG. Candidates can only run in an LTG election for their home club's division.*

Once a candidate is identified, they must follow the steps outlined below to run for office:

1. **Declare their candidacy** by signing up during registration on Friday at District Convention. Among the different stations at registration, there will be a table for LTG election sign-ups.
2. **Prepare a 2-minute speech** to present during their divisional caucus on Saturday morning. Following their speech, delegates from the division will be given **up to three (3) minutes** to ask them questions about their qualifications and campaign platform.
3. Elected LTGs must **attend the 2018-19 District Board Meeting** on Sunday morning following the Farewell Brunch. The meeting will be brief and will cover important details, dates and expectations for incoming officers.

When will elections take place?

- Lieutenant governor elections will take place during **divisional caucuses** on Saturday morning (10 a.m.) at District Convention.
- LTG elections will occur **at the end of divisional caucuses**, following caucusing by all candidates seeking executive offices and endorsement for Key Club International positions.
- At the conclusion of caucusing for executive and international candidates, delegates will separate into groups according to their club's division. Candidates for LTG will caucus **only to club delegates from their division**.
- Following caucusing (speeches and questions) from each candidate, the division's delegates (no more than 2 per club) will cast their ballots to elect their LTG.
- **Results** from the election **will be announced during the Farewell Brunch** on Sunday.
