



WHERE IT ALL STARTED



THE PROJECT



My Governor's Project: Igniting Literacy is a state-wide service project for Georgia Key Club members to raise awareness of youth literacy rates. The initiative utilizes strategies such as building Little Libraries, organizing book drives, using Schoolhouse.world for remote tutoring, and programs like Ferst Readers to provide books for children aged 1-5 years old. These efforts aim to make books more accessible, provide personalized support for struggling readers, and instill a love for reading from an early age.



GEORGIA STATISTICS

Georgia ranks 42nd in the nation with a literacy rate of 76.4%. According to the spring 2023 Georgia Milestones tests, 34.1% of Georgia third graders are reading below grade level. Additionally, nearly 58% of third graders were not prepared for the literacy challenges of the next grade level in 2019.








RECEIVING RECOGNITION:
